The main goal is to help the Mediterranean region to be at the forefront of global sustainable tourism.







## Regenera4MED RESULTS

The project will focus on three main elements:

Regenerative tourism model

Testing and operationalizing a new regenerative tourism model in six pilot regions: **Catalonia, Liguria, Abruzzo, Crete, Corsica and Split-Dalmatia** to promote a new way of understanding and doing tourism that considers climate change, social and environmental resilience and leaves a positive impact in the territory.

Regenerative experiences

Developing and testing **13 regenerative tourism experiences** to offer sustainable travel options that go beyond sustainability and strengthen local economies, preserve local heritage & culture and benefit both visitors and residents.

- **3** Creation of knowledge and tools
  - The Regenera4MED Blueprint: A practical guide for regions and communities to co-create regenerative tourism systems.
  - Local strategic plans for regenerative tourism: To help define shared goals, concrete actions, and how to monitor progress over time.
  - A guide to EU funding for regenerative tourism: To help local actors turn ideas into action, this guide explains how to access EU funding.
  - Long-term sustainability plans for each destination: To ensure lasting impact beyond the project.
